On Tuesday 17th December we will be holding our Christmas Party. Children can come in traditional or party clothes. The Nursery will provide the party food.

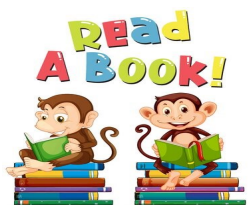


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## Library Visit

We understand that sometimes emergencies happen and someone new will have to collect your child. If this is the case please ensure that you call the school office to notify staff.
