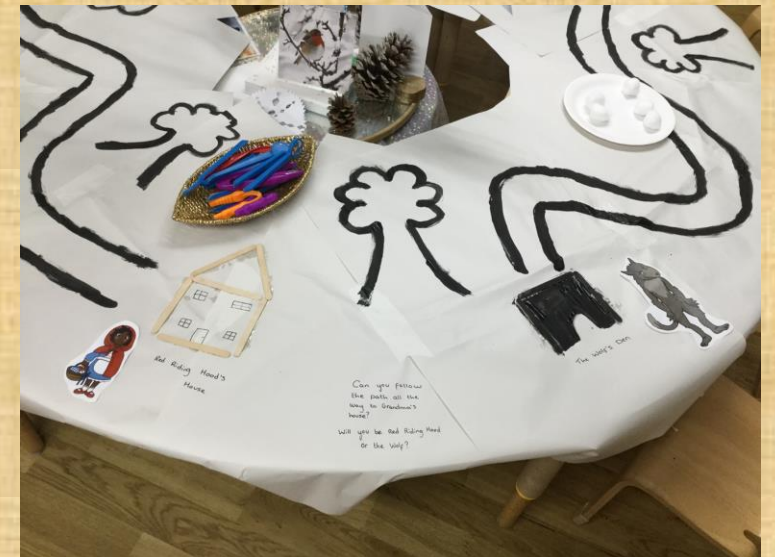


This term our focus has been traditional tales. We have enjoyed reading Goldilocks and the Three Bears, Little Red Riding Hood and The Three Little Pigs.
