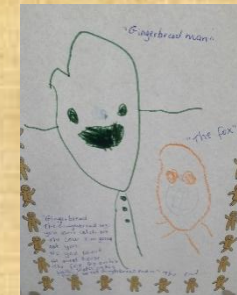


Traditional Tales

The children took part in different activities and used available props to support story telling. They showed great interest in the stories as they joined in with repeated refrains.



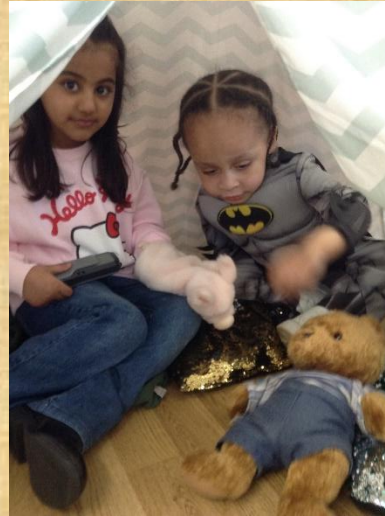
Fine Motor Development
