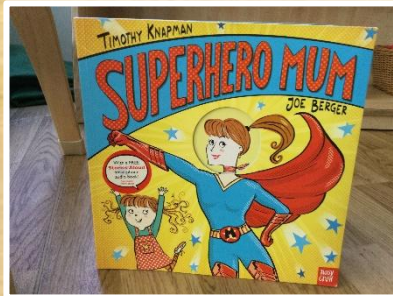




## Mother's Day Celebrations
