This has supported the children's language, thoughts and ideas through their play and talking about their own experiences or pets from home.



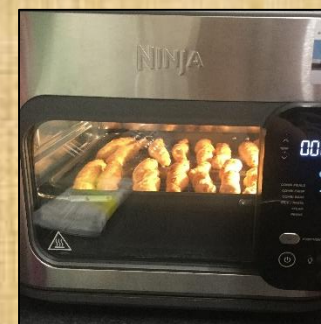
Making cheese twists
