Sun Safe

It is vital your child has **sun cream** applied before school. They must also wear a **sun hat** with their name clearly written on the label. Children must wear sturdy school shoes and not sandals or crocs to be able to play on the outdoor equipment for their safety.

Sun hats are available to buy from the office for £4.00 each.

To keep your child safe in the sun you should make sure your child:

- Cover up by wearing a T-shirt and cap
 - Remember children burn more easily
- Use Sun factor cream

Snack Time

If you prefer to pay in bulk, please see the office for a **School Fund / Snack Money** letter.

We rely on parents paying this in order to fund food we offer for snack. If you do not want to pay in bulk, please pay £1.00 every Monday.

Collection List

We would like to remind parents that any changes to their child's list of who can collect their child are made **before** the day of collection. This is so that your child's group leader can meet the new person on the list and that they can recognise them at collection time.

To add someone onto your child's collection list, please come to the main office to add them onto the list. Please ensure that this is **before** the day you want them to collect your child.

We understand that sometimes emergencies happen and someone new will have to collect your child. If this is the case please ensure that you call the school office to notify staff. You will need to be able to; give a description of the person collecting, their name, their contact number, your child's password and what their relation to the child is.

Accidents at Nursery

Sometimes children need their clothes changing at nursery if they get dirty or wet. Please send a change of clothes in their bag each day. If we do change your child into nursery clothes then please **wash and dry them before bringing them back to nursery as soon as possible**. This is so that we have spare clothes for next time.

We are currently running low on pants and socks. Donations of these are most welcome.

Child Safety

It is very important that when you bring your child to school that you make sure the group leader knows your child is here. Do not walk away without speaking to your child's group leader first. Also, at the end of the session, please wait for the group leader to call your child's name for them to come to you. **This is so that we can keep your children safe.**
