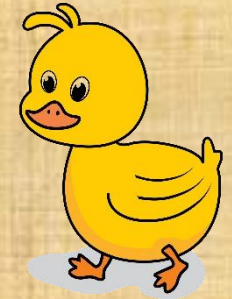


Ducklings

The children had chance to have a closer look at the animals and finding out how they feel by stroking them gently.

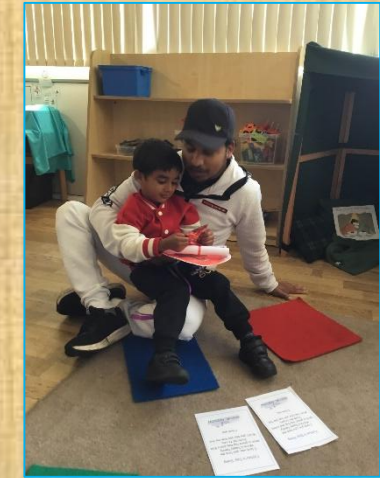


Eid Party
