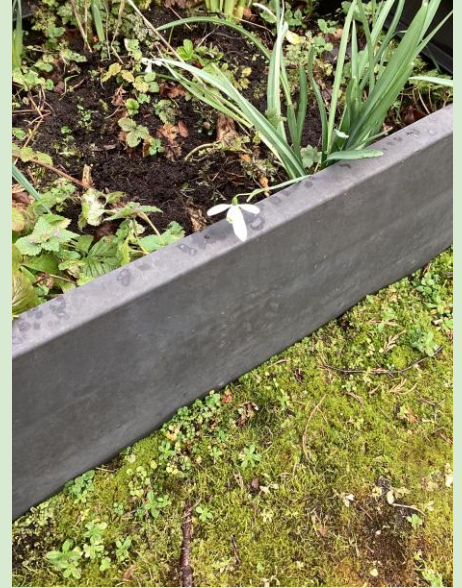


# Alumwell Nursery Garden Adventures

## Session 5 - Signs of Spring

We used old pine cones and mixed some seeds and cheese in some butter and pushed the mixture into the pine cones and hung them in the trees for the birds. We hope they like them.
