We made a poppy wreath using hand prints to mark Remembrance day

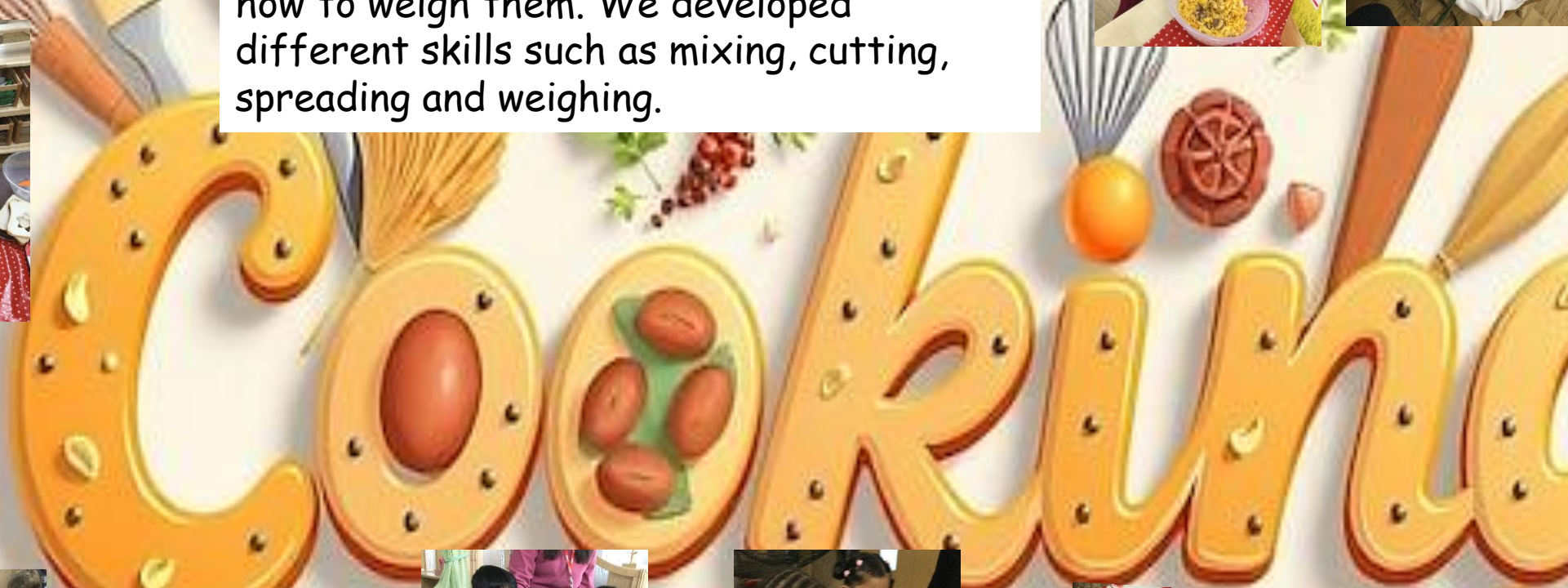
