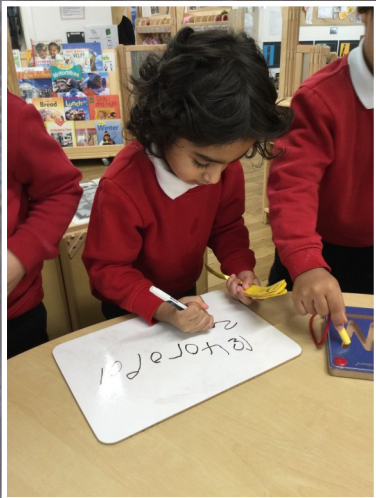


Number and Shape

We explored shape, using the hammer and tacks and arranging. The children copied the pictures by selecting the correct shapes to make the characters.



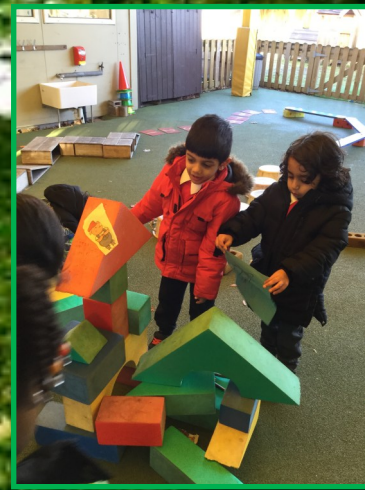
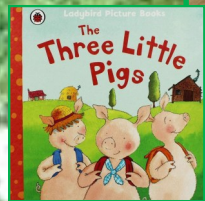
Traditional Stories
