We have enjoyed number play by making a rolling and pushing game.

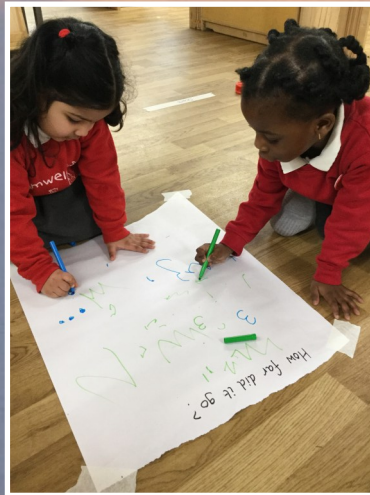
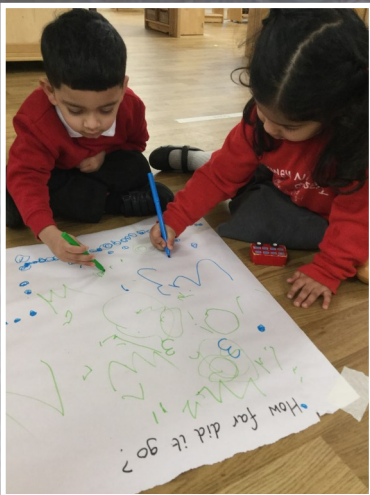
You roll or push your construction or car along the number track to see how far it goes. What number did you get to? How many is that? Now write your number on the paper. We explored mark making and numbers on paper.

## Maths Stay and Play



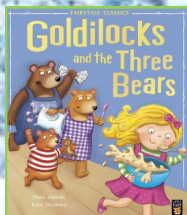
