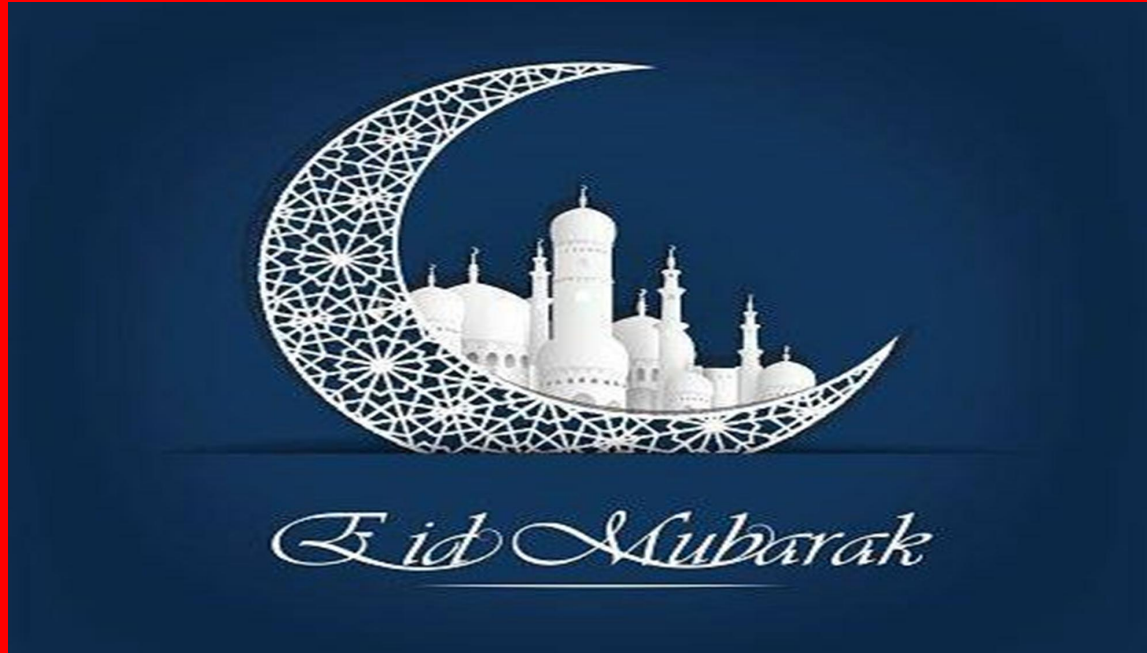
World Book Day

A day to dress up as a favourite character from the books we read...

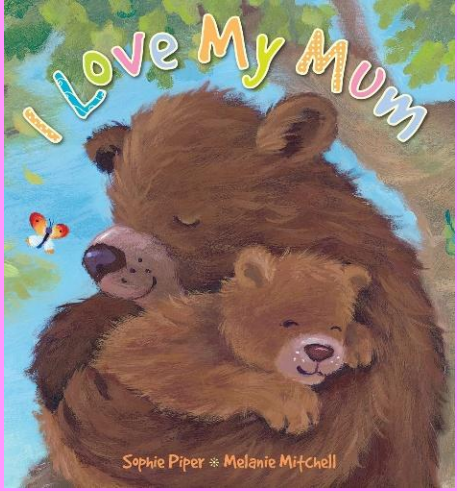
We have be able to chose new stories that we have not read before.

Forest School Adventure

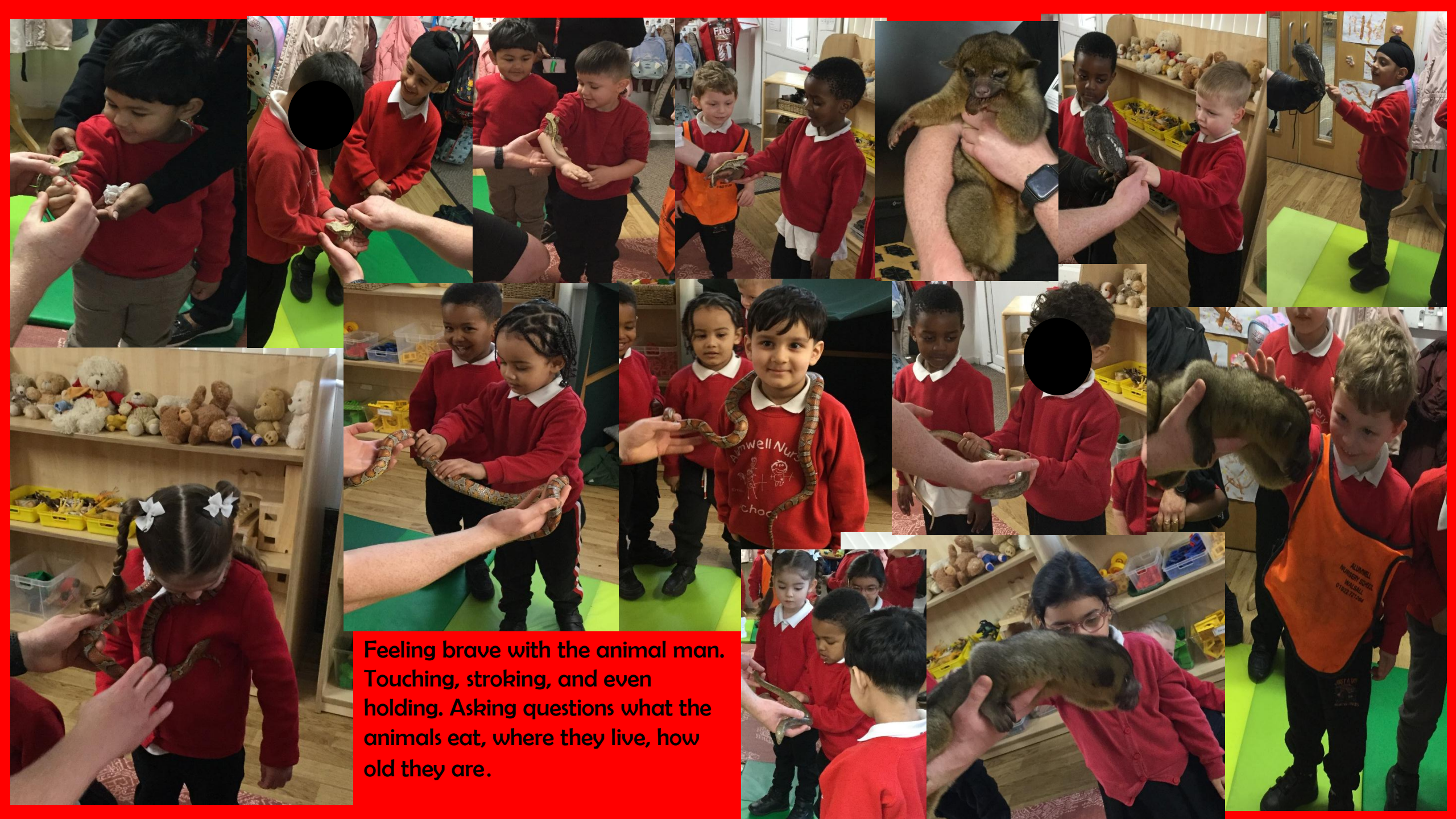
